E. NPKUA Update –

Attended Biomarin's Patient Advocacy Summit - Amazing - Lots of ideas

- -Big sibling/Little sibling mentorship program (16-25 y/o paired with 10-16 y/o)
- -PKU adult hotline for help to get back to a clinic. Kim will email Matt the link or webpage.
- -Join forces with other Advocacy groups: Crohn's, CF, Celiac, eosinophilia etc
- PKU Adults want information to understand insurance coverage and lingo (annual meeting breakout session?) Soo Shim to speak about this?
- -Patient authorization forms at our events that will consent to allow Biomarin to reach out as a care organization. No Biomarin needs to have their own table with their own flyers.
- -Elementary/high school low protein food drives to create emergency care packages, maybe Thanksgiving Care packages to families in need.
- -Reach out to high school (NHS students) and college students to start their own fundraiser (food drive, 5K walk, chuck-a-puck, bake sale etc) in return for volunteer hours.
- -Other ideas: March Madness 50/50 bracket to go to scholarship fund (college theme), Fantasy football league.
